List of documents to be uploaded on application form:

1. Matriculation / School Leaving Certificate authenticated by the governmental authorities;
2. Transcript of Records issued by your high school/ senior secondary school to certify a successful completion of Biology and Chemistry courses;
3. Certificate proving the knowledge of English language (TOEFL – 60, IELTS – 5.5, or adequate);
4. Brief CV;
5. Copy of passport or National Identity Card;
6. Health Certificate based on complete medical examination;
7. Passport type photograph.

Entrance Examination

Entrance examination includes MCQ test and interview that shall be accomplished till July 1st. MCQ test is based on high school curriculum (30 questions in Biology, 30 in Chemistry). Both, the test and the interview, are conducted in English language.

Place for you to stay

First year students have priority to apply for accommodation at the university's hostel. Students are accommodated in double-room boxes. The box has one bathroom to be shared by two rooms and one kitchen serves for the whole floor. Internet access is available in all rooms. Many students consider renting an apartment in the city center or next to the university's campus.

Monthly fee at the University's hostel

(room shared by 2 students):

- 12 sq. m. room approx. – 80 - 90 EUR / per person
- 18 sq. m. room approx. – 90 - 110 EUR / per person

How to reach the Lithuanian University of Health Sciences

Students can arrive to Lithuania by plane to Vilnius International Airport (100 km east to Kaunas) or Kaunas International Airport. Direct bus and train services run between Vilnius and Kaunas. When in Kaunas one can take a taxi to reach the International Relations and Study Centre (address: A. Mickevičiaus 9, Kaunas).
