STUDIES AT VMU

DEGREE STUDIES

Over 30 bachelor & master degree study programmes are being taught in English in the fields of:

biomedical sciences | creative arts & design humanities | physical sciences | social sciences

PhD studies are provided jointly with 23 partner institutions, in Lithuania and abroad, in the scientific fields of humanities, biomedicine, and the physical and social sciences.

Bachelor - 1700-5320 EUR/year **Master** - 2600-6200 EUR/year **PhD** - 5450-8180 EUR/year

FREE MOVER STUDIES

Single courses at bachelor or master's level in English for 1 or 2 semesters are available. After studies, Free Mover students receive a Transcript of Records. It is a perfect way to collect some international credits.

EXCHANGE STUDIES

Bachelor, Master and PhD degree students have a possibility to take part in various exchange programmes (Bilateral exchange, Erasmus+) for studies and internships and can receive monthly scholarships ranging from 300 to 700 EUR per month.

STUDENT SUPPORT

SCHOLARSHIPS

Each year VMU offers scholarships to prospective bachelor or master degree students. These scholarships cover the full tuition fee for one semester or the entire study period at VMU.

Education 360°

Lithuanian state scholarships are offered for full-time master degree studies for nationals of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, China, Georgia, Israel, Japan, Moldova, South Korea, and Ukraine, as well as foreigners of Lithuanian origin. Winners might receive a monthly scholarship and benefits to cover study fees in Lithuania.

ACCOMMODATION

VMU has three dormitories. A place in one of the university's dormitories is guaranteed for full time students for the first study year. Accommodation costs approximately 60-150 EUR/month.

COST OF LIVING

Lithuania is considered an inexpensive country to live. Students who study in Kaunas should expect to budget 250-600 EUR per month, which includes:

- Dormitory/flat rent 60-200 EUR
- Food 130-200 EUR
- Learning aid 10-50 EUR
- Leisure activities 100-300 EUR
